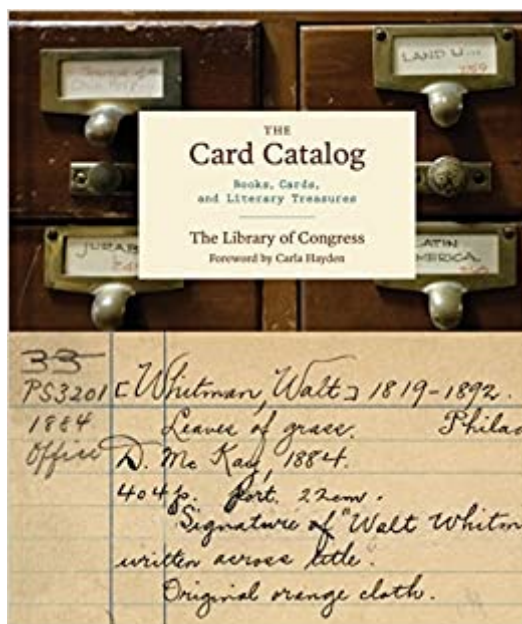

An interesting book on the Congressional Library. Has an over abundance of pictures and illustrations that don't really contribute to the overall story. It does have a place in the overall understanding of library development, but there are other sources available on that do a more complete review of that topic. Some of them do not cover all the years that book does, so it does have a niche. I read this book as a result of a review in a local newspaper and am not sorry that I did. If your interests are library science or how the Congressional Library operates, then this book will be of interest. It is marginally useful if your interest in the larger topic of information or knowledge management.
