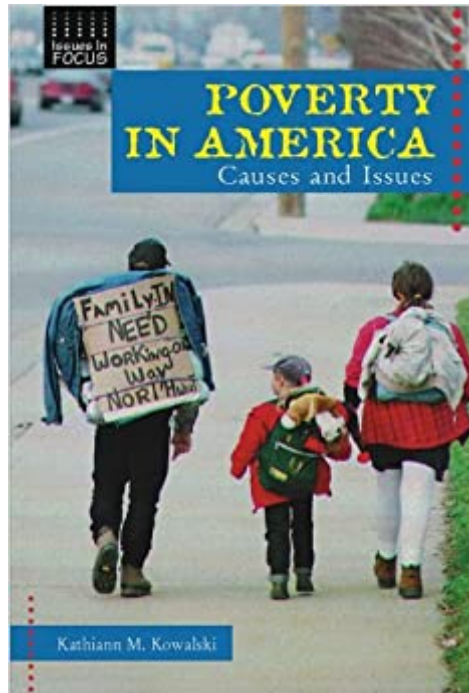

Grade 6 Up-Kowalski tackles a tough topic and makes balanced sense of it. She begins by addressing issues of unequal wealth and the differences between absolute poverty, in which survival is on the line, and relative poverty, in which people live in an "underclass" of shabbiness and hand-me-downs. Chapter two takes on the stereotypes of the poor, defines "poverty levels" and demographics, then looks at various groupings and their specific problems. Chapter three presents a chronological context of U.S. government attempts to deal with the poor and eliminate poverty, which segues into a balanced discussion of the welfare system in all its controversy. Homelessness and housing concerns are then described and clarified, and an important chapter effectively presents the dilemmas facing the working poor. The final chapter looks at ways in which private organizations and individuals are trying to assist those in need. Extensive chapter notes are evidence of the thorough research.
