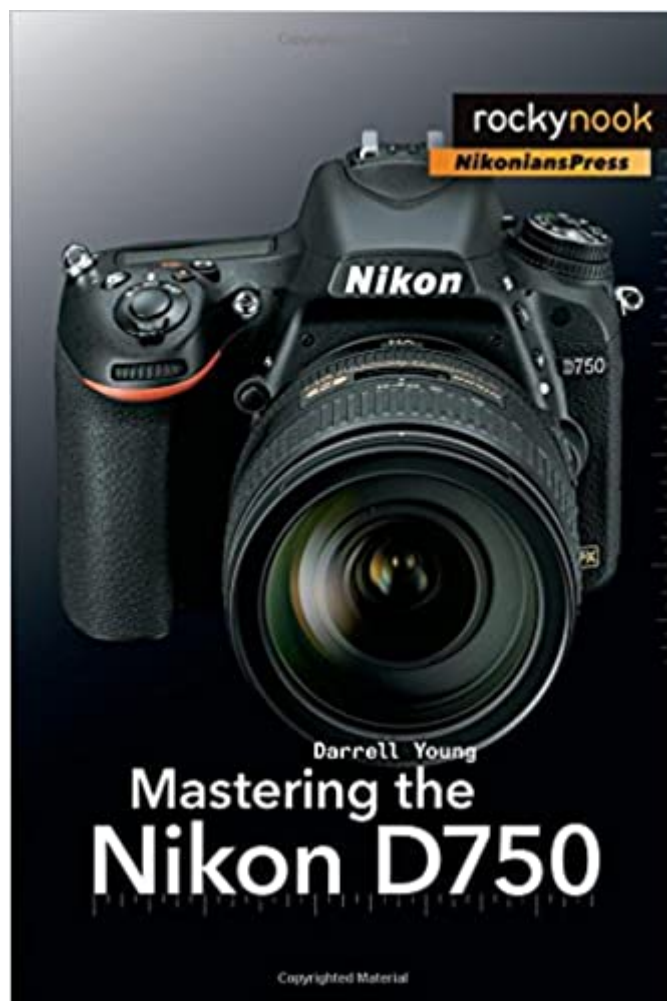

Probably goes into too much detail about things more like a reference manual, but it certainly is comprehensive and I am working my way through the entire thing on my Kindle. Helps to understand all the camera features (such as sRGB vs. Adobe RGB) to make best use of the camera. Won't necessarily make you a better photographer, but at least the camera won't get in the way when it doesn't have to! It is more than the camera manual regurgitated.

Excellent book, takes you through the whole setup for Nikon D750. I like that in many instances, they give you the page number in the Nikon manual, so you can check two sources for the more sophisticated features of the camera. Great book.
