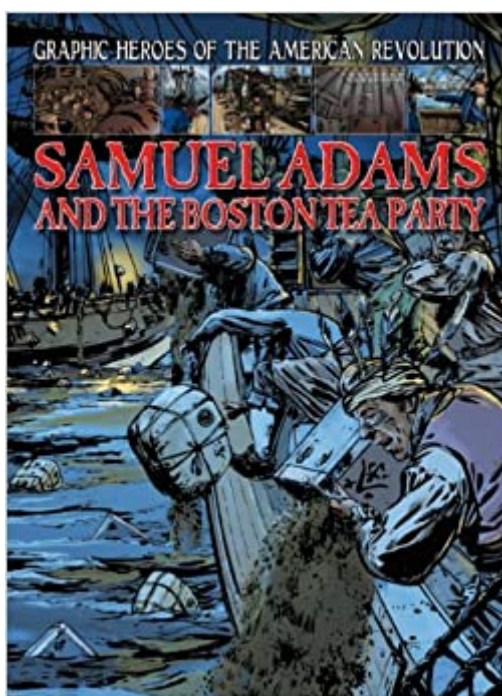

What's all this fuss about tea again? A two-page note swiftly sets the stage for the insurrection of the Sons of Liberty against the British Crown, explaining why the tea tax was symbolic of so much more. Then we're off to graphic-novel land, with Adams delivering two rousing speeches to thousands of antsy protesters. There's probably a limit to how excitingly a speech can be rendered, but after the patriots (disguised as Mohawk Indians) take to the streets, Spender's night-blue and fire-orange illustrations capably convey the tumult of the marauding rebels and the seething of the waves that swallow the tea. The shocked King George looks expectedly fatuous,

and it ends with noble Adams anticipating the oncoming war. Easily comprehensible and sporadically exciting, this title bodes well for the rest of the Graphic Heroes of the American Revolution series. Grades 4-7. --Daniel Kraus --This text refers to the Library Binding edition.
