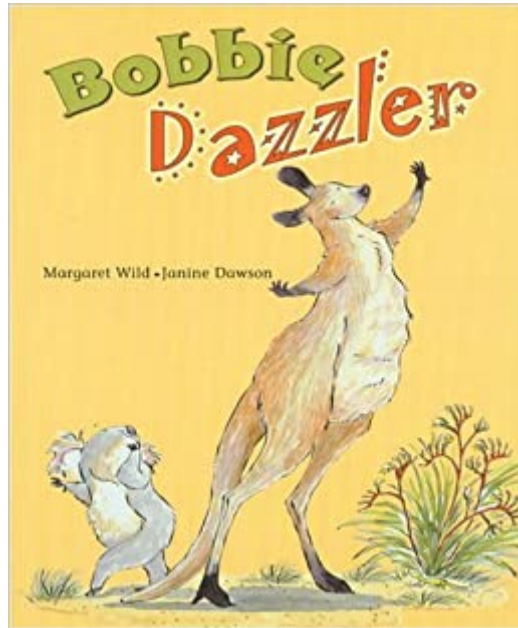

One morning, the determined animal finally manages to slide into the desired position, but she can't get up without the help of her friends. Eventually, with lots of practice, Bobbie and her pals master the tricky maneuver. This story of encouragement doesn't have much of a plot, but the straightforward message is sure to be understood by even the youngest readers.
