

Her books illustrated for Penguin Random House include *Phoebe the Sky*; *Anna, Grandpa, and the Big Storm*; and *What's the Big Idea, Ben Franklin?*

This was one of the first books my daughter was fascinated by in our history curriculum and it just

so happens that I had chosen it to substitute something else. Best decision I made in substitution. It is a fantastic book based in real facts (though I'm not sure to what extent) that my daughter could engage in but also that helped her interact with history in a way that now she knows some of the challenges of the time, some information of the character of George Washington as well as the dynamic of the issue of slavery and race in the time period and a mature way of processing these issues in a way my 6 year old could begin to understand a complex concept.

My students loved it! After a SS unit on the Revolutionary War, this was a great book for them to experience the historical fiction genre.
