

I downloaded this study book for the purpose of taking a few practice exams to warm up for the Lit subject test. I studied quite extensively for the SAT (which paid \$ off) and can honestly say that this book is a waste of time. The poor selections, ambiguous questions and answers, and often incorrect answers, already mark the book as lower quality, but the frequent typos and lack of numbered lines for selected readings make it downright bad. And the strategies section, which is intended to instruct readers of the differing types of questions and ways to answer them, is much too basic, and, like the rest of the book, completely useless. Very unsatisfied.

This book focuses way too much on the technicalities of English Literature. I wish that they had more emphasis on how to infer and break down difficult passages. After going through this book, I still felt confused as certain things were not explained clearly. They do have a lot of practice passages, but then again, they focus way too much on technical things. Perhaps I'm just not suited for Literature, but this book did not help me in the actual test.

The passages in this book doesn't have line numbers -- which the practice questions refer to all the time! Since it is impossible to count the line number due to the fact that kindle readers re-arrange the lines, the practice tests are practically impossible to work on. If you want to seek an ebook, please put in at least a little bit of effort to ensure that it functions in the way paperbacks are meant to function.

It's a very good book, it contains a review of the things you need to know for the exam such as retorical figures, it has a lot of practice questions, most of the time harder than the real exam, which is really good because when you take the real one you feel that is so easy.
