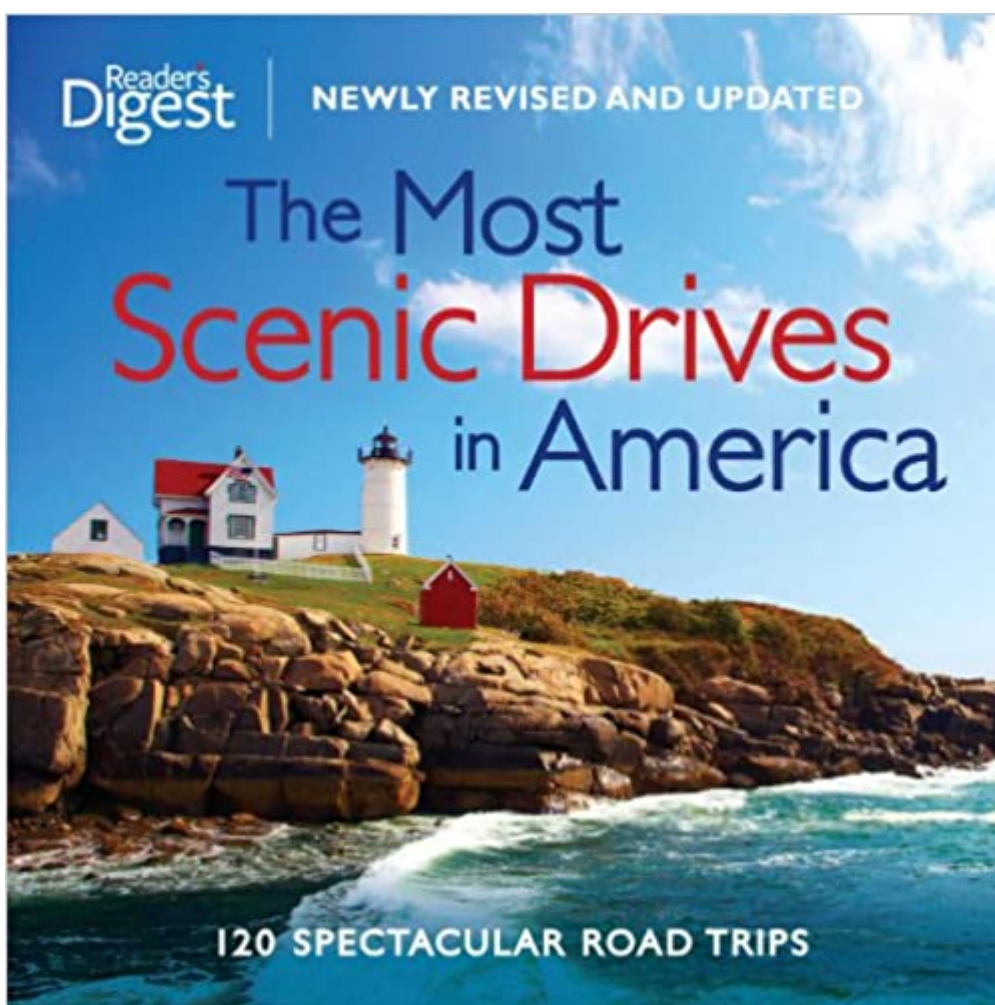

Very good material, but almost impossible to use. The first section (area) is the West Coast, the second Rocky Mountain. These two at least have an index of the routes covered within them, but there is no beginning index to tell you what page to go to to find those two indices. Even worse, from there on out, there not even the regional indices! The index at the back helps IF you know the name of what you are looking for, but if you buy this book to find places you may not have known about, or if you don't know the exact name of what you want, you are out of luck. You cannot, for example, find the drives within a given state. This is just plain sloppy work, showing the people responsible don't care. Heads should roll on this one (and many other ineptly-done books as well). Shame on those responsible.
