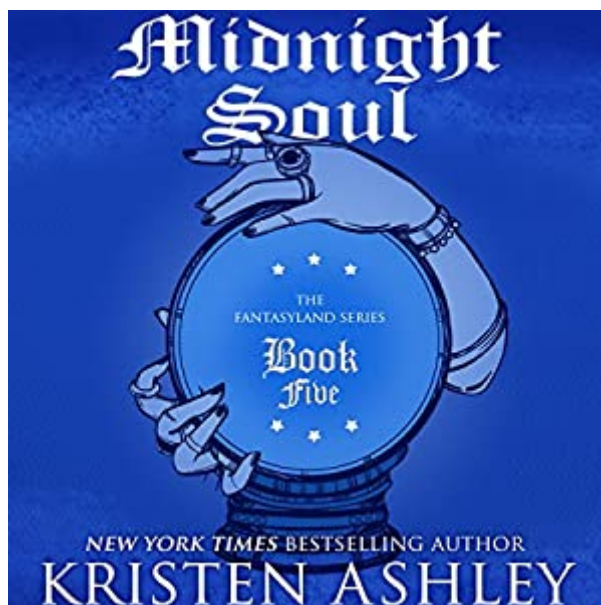

I'm a huge fan of Kristens. But when I bought the book I was expecting what she normally writes. I would not buy this book til it was .99 cents or free. It was boring, lacked adventure. The man was a kiss ass man to me. And there was really no story line about the heroine. More of a write itn at the end just skip to when they are old and have kids. Nothing really exciting at all. Very disappointed in this book.

This book starts out wonderfully, and all I could think was "Kristin's back." Then it was so painfully boring that I wanted to cry. Until a faux conflict for 10 pages at the end. At least I didn't hate the characters like in Magdalena series. I didn't even finish those. Disappointed.
