

An excellent little book which efficiently and comprehensively summarizes the basics of Italian grammar for those of us who have Italian as an acquired language and lack the opportunity to use it beyond our visits to Italy. The information is logically and clearly laid out for quick and easy reference. I find it eminently readable, and try to go through it completely to refresh my knowledge before each trip to Italy. The small size makes it easy to pack, and to carry around while visiting people and places. I have given copies to U.S. friends studying Italian and to Italian friends studying English. They have been utterly delighted because the division of topics, format, and careful planning of the material have helped them understand, clarify and relate the language that were studying to their mother tongue.

This was one of the first books I bought to study Italian. It is compact, yet covers all major aspects of

the Italian grammar. However, some may want to delve into more detailed aspects, and find more examples in spite of having enough for many semesters to learn. I learned a lot from this book, and I still do. The only thing I missed was the easy and quick way to search topics, which I have grown accustomed to with my Kindles. I would hope a Kindle version of this book were also published.Professor Danesi wrote more books, several of which I purchased. I find his style well adapted also to self-study. The coverage of subjects is laid out logically. A lot of knowledge is packed into this small book. I wish I were still at his university so that I could benefit from his teaching in his class.

I bought this at the same time I bought Barron's Italian Idioms and this book is just as good as the other. It is slightly larger than a paperback so it fits in my bag abd I can take it with me to study on the train. If you're looking for a book to improve your Italian grammer this is an excellent choice.
