I used to buy these from the Savvy Traveller store on Michigan Avenue but now that they're available on it's much simpler. I give the Chicago map to out-of-town guests and VanDam's maps of other world cities to friends who are planning trips. The detail in all of them is amazing, including the 3-D renderings of important buildings. The laminate holds up through lots of use, the unfolded size is much more manageable than the usual paper maps, and the typography is both stylish and readable. The Beijing map actually has street and place names in Chinese characters, pinyin romanization, and English. Can't go wrong with these.
