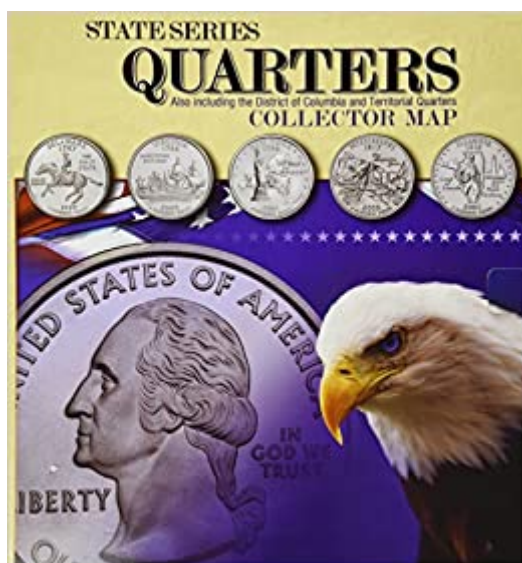

I ordered this book for my growing collection of the new states quarters. I really liked this booklet as it folds out, has tight little pockets to punch the quarters into so they do not fall out & there is a color coded system that assists you finding the states that are released together during certain yrs. I wish I could find another that matches for the other series of quarters that I have collected over the yrs so they could sit together on the shelf. You will find that this booklet sits well on a book shelf right side up with the outside binder facing out not facing down on its binder like the tall dark blue ones that I have previously ordered over the yrs from the mint.

Bought this for my collection of US States Series Quarter Coins. It is so colorful and very educational with some information about each states. It also includes space allotted for the special six coins for US Territories that I find hard to collect afterwards so bought them in as well just to complete it. Nice gift for kids or any body who is into this kind of hobby.

They are the same exact size and, while the actual colors and pictures on it are different, they look very much like each other- which is what I was hoping for. They also have a nice little fold over tab to keep them closed. This one's is made with a magnet to hold the closure (vs Velcro on the other).

This is such a high quality and informative collector piece! I got this for my 8 year old daughter, and she LOVES it! The facts that are inside the tri-fold are great learning tools, and even her having to find the individual states was like a home-school geography lesson that was also fun! It is honestly a lot thicker material than I expected, and if anyone says the quarters don't go in or don't stay they should probably make sure they know the difference between a quarter and a nickel - this thing holds EVERY quarter securely in place! Highly recommend to anyone at any age!

I bought these for my nephew and niece in INDIA as I think these (with the quarters in of course) would be excellent gift for them to learn more about US in a simple yet interesting way..Now, I must say I am extremely happy with my purchase and have to say that it is money well spent.Pros:easy to place the coins in their spots and they are held tight.. the most important thing I felt is if you want to replace a coin, it is easy to take one out and put another back in with ease and without any damage of the coin slot. I like the recess provided with each coin slot for this purpose.good and concise description of the states and overall a nice item to hold on to and display.nice and sturdy cardboard, but not too

heavy. Cons nothing significant.. minor points to mention which might be a bit of surprize. size: some people might find the size (even after folding) bit large. Extra slots: the album contains slots for the DC & US territories Quarters released in 2009 in addition to the 50 states. while the 50 state quarters are not that hard to find these 2009 quarters (Guam, US Virgin Islands, Washington DC, Puerto Rico, American Samoa, and Northern Mariana Islands) are extremely hard to find in circulation. so chances are you might end up having your collection incomplete and have empty slots in the album. Summary very good product and certainly will recommend this.
