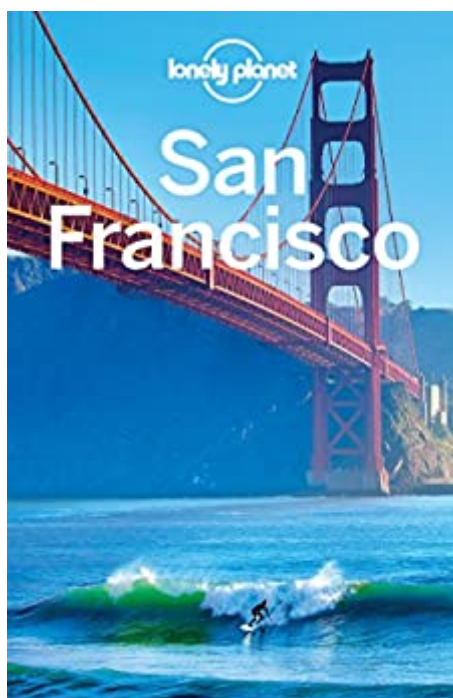

I am reading this on Kindle so that it is easy to take on our trip. The ability to zoom in on illustrations, the links to websites, and the links to maps, makes this information and this format very usable.

It has an exhaustive section on San Francisco. However, it would be better if Lonely Planet expands this to include the whole Bay Area or even just a section on Silicon Valley since those areas are interlinked. And chances are, you'd also be visiting other areas south of SFO aside from the places mentioned in the guidebook like Napa and Sausalito, which are mostly on the Northern part.
