

It was not exactly what I had expected. The book as far as I have read, which is a little over half has good information for the shooter and some for the handloader. I originally thought since Parker Ackley was the author it would have an explanation of his "Ackley Improved" cases so popular with handloaders. I have yet to see any discussion on the subject. But what I have read is the very best in advice and use. I would like to update my review. Having now read most of the book, and having read the articles, chapters, by P.O. Ackley. volume 2 was available in Kindle. I also know why there is no discussion on P.O. Ackley's methods on improving cartridges. He gave us the reasons and some of the changes through his selection of authors included in his book, but he also was selling rifles, ammo, and working in his own gunsmith shop as well as teaching gunsmithing. Which only adds to his credibility and explains why he doesn't explain his methods. With the information given it will not be hard to come up with your own method and your own wildcat.

I was not very impressed with this book. The book "Handloading Ammunition" by JR Mattern was a MUCH better read than this and had more relevant information to a wider variety of people. A lot of the stuff in this book is only of interest to people who are specifically into the details of Ackley's various wildcats, what his (somewhat borderline dangerous) loads were, as well as his personal views on some things. The chapters seem to jump around from random topic to random topic without any overall clear picture of where the book is going. I actually sent it back I was so disappointed in it.If you like old reloading books that are still every bit as good today, I can't speak highly enough about "Handloading Ammunition" by JR Mattern and "Why Not Load Your Own?" by Townsend Whelen. Those two are excellent.

This book is essential for all re-loaders and serious shooters. Ackley is a legend and this book is a real jem.

This is a must-have book for any shooting, hunting, reloading enthusiast. Most of the info is timeless, and the wildcat cartridges section unique.Perfect for a browse at any time, and a reference when dealing with shooting matters, or preparing for a hunt.
