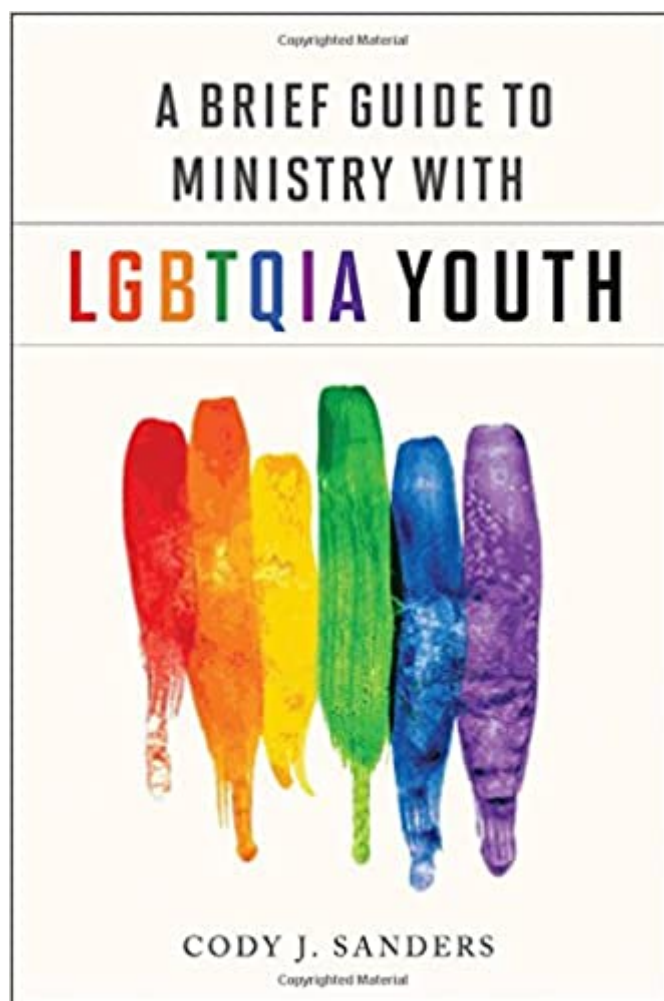

A Brief Guide to Ministry with LGBTQIA Youth (Westminster John Knox Press, 2017) by Cody J. Sanders is a timely and needed tool for pastors and youth leaders hoping to engage today's youth. Of course there are segments of the conservative church who will ignore what is known about human sexuality and gender identity and attempt to force youth to conform to literal and restrictive readings of Genesis 1: "we are either male or female, the only acceptable attractions are between male and female, and the purpose of intimacy is procreation. This book is not for them. Those folks need to do relationship and get educated in the basics about human sexuality and gender identity before they are even trusted with the lives and souls of LGBTQIA youth. But, if you already know these LGBTQIA kids are precious and not in need of fixing their orientation or gender identity and want to help disciple them in faith, Sanders' book is a great primer and resource. Sanders begins with terminology which for some will be an expansion on simple "gay-straight" categories. Next he covers sexual and affectional orientations. Not all intimate interactions result in sex. There is a brief guide of ministry question, first some considerations helping LGBTQIA youth directly (coming out and inviting into one's world, bullying, homelessness, suicides and making referrals for additional help) then, helping the parents and families of LGBTQIA youth (family rejection, conflict in the family, finding supportive communities) and finally, help for pastors and mentors of LGBTQIA youth. If you want to create safe and welcoming environments in your churches and teach your community of youth to be more loving and respectful of those who have traditionally been marginalized, and even ostracized, start with Sanders' book. It will help you move forward in love, and if you already welcoming to LGBTQIA youth, it will help you get better.
