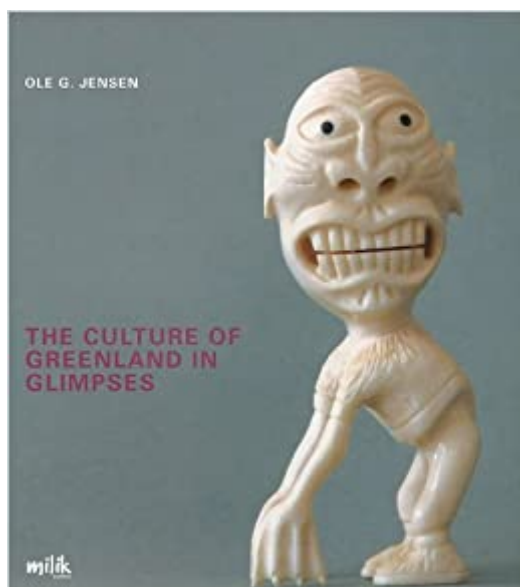

Jensen came to Greenland in 1975 and has held, amongst others, the position of information officer/consultant with the Greenland Home Rule's Ministry of Culture. Most recent employment: leader of the museum in Tasiilaq in East Greenland (1995-2006) and in Qaqortoq in South Greenland (2006-). Most of the articles and photos in this book came into being during the long, inspiring stay in Tasiilaq. Ole G. Jensen has written and taken photos of Greenland for a wide

range of newspapers and periodicals.
