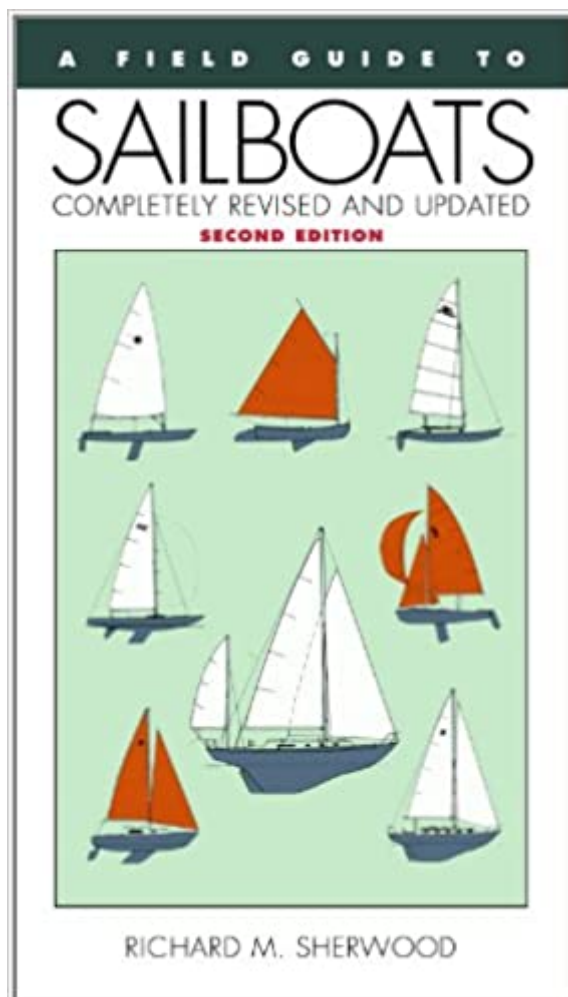

Richard M. Sherwood, a lifelong sailor, lives in Amherst, New Hampshire.

The author lives in New Hampshire, which shows in the coverage of boat models: obscure (to the point of apparent one-off) small New England boats are fanatically represented, but larger production models are hit/miss. Many build-from-plans models are present, but the Catalina 27, with more than 6600 hulls built, is absent, but something called a Marsh Hen with a whopping 40 built is present. The front matter and glossary are decent, with a number of diagrams showing bow shapes, etc. The boat descriptions are split into One Design / Small and Cruiser / Auxiliaries sections, a division that's awkward and sometimes arbitrary. The terms used to describe boat features aren't always consistent among models, which somewhat confounds comparisons. For the 44 cents plus shipping I paid I guess I got good value.

My interest in and curiosity about a number of smaller sailboats was more than adequately satisfied

by this wonderful little volume. The delivery was fast, the price reasonable. I am more than happy with the transaction
