

This manual of instruction for lay persons called upon to treat medical problems in the absence of a professional is, to my knowledge, the best source of information for people who read Spanish. I recently gave copies to each of three Mayan families of my acquaintance in rural Guatemala--all of which include one or more family members who read Spanish. And I have suggested to executives of the NGO through which we are connected to make copies of this manual available to all other sponsors for distribution to other such families--at a discounted price, I hope, as \$24 is steep. We are talking about thousands of families in a Guatemala alone, though there are many other countries served by this NGO. There are other books in this series, which address the particular medical issues of women, for example, as well one about dental problems. These books have been translated into many other languages.
