Bought it as prep for our own trip down the Middle Fork but didn't find it to be very helpful for learning about the river and the various drops. If you've never rafted with a commercial outfitter, this book does a good job of describing the experience so it could be helpful for someone trying to decide "Is this type of trip for me?". Sort of like watching someone's slide show.

This is a great read for anyone who believes that life should be an adventure. One father and two teens having an amazing experience in the wilderness. Who knew it was even possible in today's techno-obsessed society? The descriptions will make you believe you could do it too.

There is so much going on around the Middle Fork the human history, the natural history, fires, wars, the whole ecology of the place. This book speaks to none of this. There was no research done beyond going on the six day trip. Perhaps I was hoping for something that this book does not intend to be, however, I believe that the Middle Fork deserves better.

Great read for parents or a family thinking about getting out in nature together. This book will give you a preview of what it would be like to sign up for a rafting trip for your next family vacation. It

shares the fun of getting outside with teenagers---yes, that can be fun--and doing something new.
