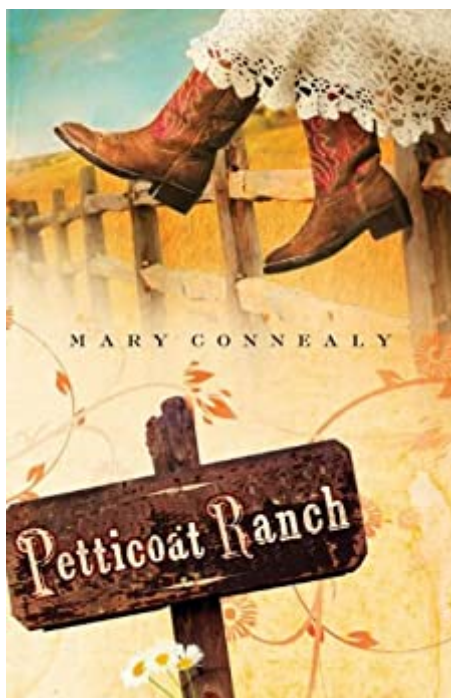

I, unfortunately, have not the history with the author at this time to want to continue reading this series immediately, I just feel I need some distance at this time. I am hoping I feel differently about them at a later time, and find that I love the 2nd and 3rd books in this series, as I would truly love to find other Christian Historical or writers that write about the Amish that I can continue to enjoy. Unfortunately, I read much faster than they write!

I started with Mandy. While reading Mandy's and then Beth's stories, I kept reading references to their mom (Sophie 's) story. So, I went looking and found it and am so glad I did. As with all Mary' s work, this story captured me from page one. Sophie and her daughters demonstrated such creativity in learning to survive. Clay kept expecting them to allow him to take care of them, never dreaming of what they were capable.

I had never read any of the Mary Connealy's books but Christian historical fiction is a favorite of mine so I selected this one based on the reviews. It was a story that at first grabbed me but half way through I knew what was coming and it was a slow read from there. The theme addressing forgiveness and revenge was drilled just a bit too often and in the same manner and just plain unrealistic even in cowboy days. I don't think I will read the rest of the series. There are other collections I find more creative.

Sophie Edwards is used to taking care of herself and her four daughters after her husband's death. Her constant prayer is, "Help me, Lord" while she does what needs to be done in the small shack they live in. Then one night, a stranger shows up and almost dies. She and the girls rescue him and find out he is Clay McClellan, the twin brother of her deceased husband. Feeling obligated to care for the woman and children his long lost brother left behind, he corners her into marrying him. She puts up a fight but decides to go along with it in order to have her ranch back. However, there's trouble brewing. Judd Mason wants that ranch and makes a plan to kill them in order to get it. Meanwhile, Clay feels inferior to his brother who seems to have done everything right while he (Clay) keeps messing things up. Sophie is determined to do the chores and fix up the place as she's

always done, and her daughters, who adore Clay, pretend to be helpless in order to soothe his ego. So Sophie and Clay constantly butt heads and argue, but even in the midst of it, there's humor. Mary Connealy does a remarkable job with comedy, and this light-hearted book will be a fun read for anyone in the mood for a little romance and suspense.
