I don't know what book the others got but the one I got wasn't worth the postage, AND THAT WAS FREE!, much less \$9.95. It has 5 "chapters". From Chapter 1 through Chapter 5 is all of 9 pages. The information is nearly useless. It is more of an expanded pamphlet. A costly pamphlet. If I could have given it a minus star review I would have. All the information I read could have been gleaned from other guide books without ever setting one foot in Italy. Like it tells you to look for free museums or days when the museums are free but they don't name one museum or give you any information you can actually use. Plus, they don't even mention you can get your tickets online before you leave home for many of the larger museums which is suggested in other real guide

books. This is a very good suggestion during peak tourist times, by the way, that this "book" fails to point out and I just gave it to you for free. One statement that makes me wonder if the writer has even been in Italy is where it says "Cinque Terra is a beautiful town" when in reality it is five towns linked together. Hence, "cinque" which means five in Italian. I agree with the other review that this is a scam and the multi-star reviews are bogus. Don't waste our money!
