

However, I started with book 1 and have read each in the order in which Dennison wrote them and I felt that I got more out of the stories. The best part or book 6 is the fact that John McCabe shares with his adult daughter, Bree, his past and as such the reader is able to put 2 and 2 together to get 4. This is a very good series that has more of the character and plot development then a typical shootem up bang--bang western. Dennison does have a strong moral compass for his characters in his westerns. If you like westerns--this is a good series. Entertaining as well as a good read.
