

He travels around the country giving case interview workshops at the top MBA programs. Cosentino also developed CQI the most sophisicated interactive case interview on-line training tool.

This book certainly has good information in it, but I feel that it is almost a little too comprehensive and limiting. The twelve frameworks offered by Cosentino were all very useful, but under the stress of an interview, I feel that it can be almost confusing. The author states that they are all very similar, so I don't know why he did not create 3 or 4 frameworks and explain how they should be expanded and modified to fit a particular situation. On the other hand, this book had a wealth of information. The sections on case thinking in general, the "Case Commandments", and the practice cases were all extremely helpful. I recommend this book to anyone going through the case interview process. The key is to focus on the mindset and not on the specific details. I got a job with a "Big 3" firm, and I owe much of that to this book.

Marc Cosentino wrote a great book because he cares. There's no mystery that if you want to succeed during your case interview, you're going to need the right tools and smart guidance. Throughout his case workshop, I knew from the get-go that Marc understood what's up. He gets it, because he knows there's something important at stake. You want to do consulting and you want to destroy your case interview. So read the book. Read it again. And practice. Marc teaches at Harvard University and tours all over the Ivy League, but these materials shouldn't be reserved only for a select group of institutions. You want to get involved. You want to learn, and you don't want to get left behind. This book is where you start getting ahead or where you start playing catchup. Either way, it's a tremendous value. Good luck.
