

Following a near-continual barrage of explicitly described bloodbaths and atrocities, Smith engineers a perfunctory happy ending, but his main intent is plainly to leave even those readers who glory in immersing themselves in staccato, gore-splashed prose a little queasy. Also, these books can get pretty gory, so I would NEVER recommend these for kids under around 14 or 15, unless they don't get scared easily. The plotline moves along quickly, and I never had to force myself to keep reading, because the books never really got boring. The characters are also very well developed. You quickly see more complex traits emerge in many of them. Overall, I loved this series, and I'm planning on reading more by this author.
