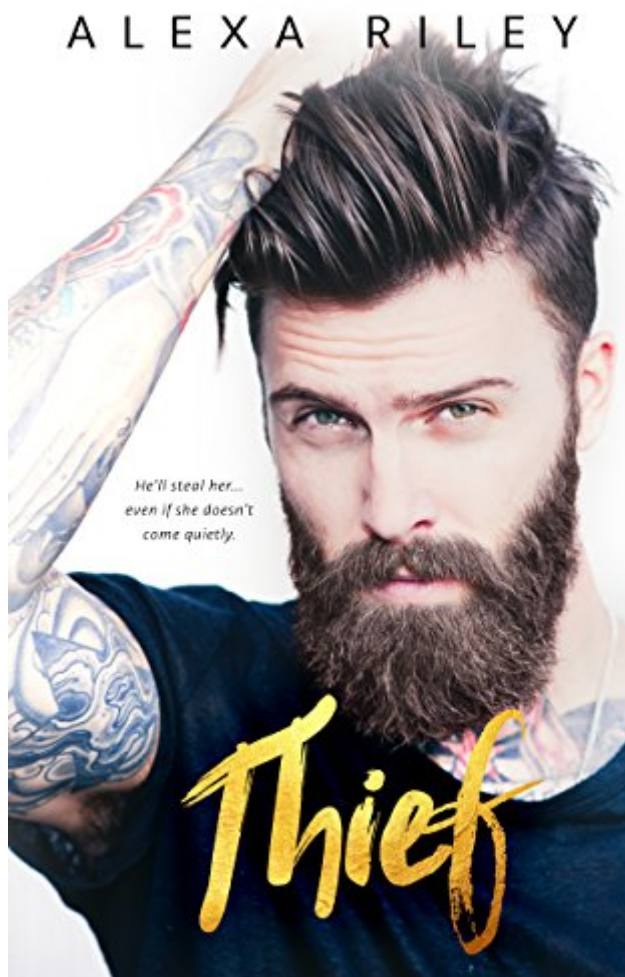

I'll start off this review by saying it isn't the worst book I've ever read, but it's close. That being said Sean totally creeped me out. Going on and on and on about "if she doesn't love me I love her enough for both of us" Yada Yada Yada.... He keeps saying he's going to give her everything she

wants yet all he can do is talk about what he wants. And for God's sake, Tessa, grow a backbone! I quickly tired of her whiny inner monologue. Warning: spoilers - obviously no research was done regarding using blanks to "shoot" someone at close range. The book describes Nick as having the gun pressed against Tessa's temple when he fired it. This would have killed her. Even though there's no bullet or projectile in the gun, the force of the gunpowder in the gun can seriously injure or kill someone, especially when pressed against a sensitive part of the body such as someone's temple. This is how John Eric Hexum accidentally killed himself on set in Hollywood years ago. Sean Sparrow is a career criminal, with his own code of honor, who specialized in taking out electronic security. He is planning his last heist and is going to retire. He has 1 problem, Tessa Morgan, the head teller at the bank he is planning on robbing. Tessa makes him think of settling down and kids, and he hasn't even met her yet. She is in danger from his partners. He has a weekend to make her fall in love with him and get her out of town fast. Tessa is a curvy, sweet, and shy girl and can't believe a guy like Sean could be interested in her. A steamy, fast paced love story. With an extremely possessive alpha man, and the curvy girl he wants to lock away and make babies with.

While this story has lots of steamy scenes, the main character Sean was way too crazy for me. His obsession with Tessa was far more creepy than romantic. The plot was completely unbelievable, especially since the bulk of the story happens over the course of a week.

This was one that got shaky in the middle. Usually, Riley plots are kept deliberately thin in order to maximize the steam and emphasize the main characters' connection. In this story, there's a lot going on. The trademark steam is there, although Sean is a less lovable and more, just likeable, heroic character. He and Tessa don't exactly get into instalove with each other, as Sean fixates and moves, and Tessa has less consent. Maybe that's what is off about this, compared to other Riley books.

Alexa Riley is my go-to when I want a quick & dirty read. Always well written and incomparably sexy, this writing duo gives their readers what I call smart smut. Thief is the third installment in the Breeding series. Sean Sparrow is set to complete his final heist before he retires when he spots Tessa for the first time. Love at first sight spins out of control in the midst of an armed robbery. Good thing Sean is a Thief, though, because he's going to need to use those skills - along with the big gun in his arsenal - to steal her... heart. An easy, super sexy, fun HEA. What a way to kill a couple of hours!! Loved it!!

I really liked the book, but the previous two titles in the series were my favorite. I liked that this book had a darker edge to it with the crime, and also the other characters of her roommate and his co-thief, but I liked the other two books because it was an alpha who wanted his girl and wanted to help her whereas this book was what she could do for him and then he returned the favor. I really love the way she writes and the book kept a very good pace. It was a book that I felt I needed to finish as soon as I got done with the first chapter.
