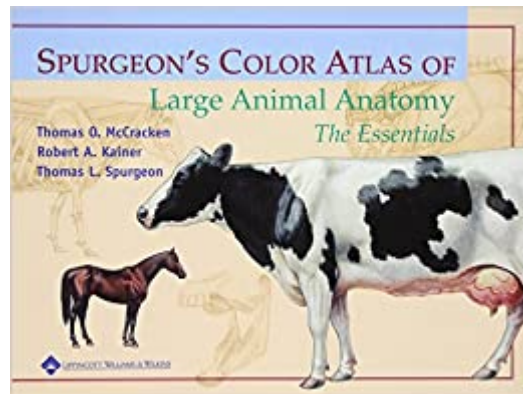

This is by far my favorite textbook in the veterinary technology program I am in. It is an excellent resource for anatomical structures for those of us without a large animal background. It is sufficiently detailed for a tech program (cannot speak for vet students), presents the pictures in an uncluttered manner, and definitely helped me to pass the midterm.
